#### Welcome to the Heart Museum

Our museum was established in 2005 by the chairman of Wada Precision Dental Laboratories Co., Ltd., Mr. Hiroki Wada, to deepen the public's understanding of teeth. Wada Precision makes nearly one million dental prostheses a year. As the name of the museum suggests, it is an art museum that displays both dental-related items (*ha* meaning tooth) and art. The museum introduces dental implant techniques and shows the process of creating a dental prosthesis. It also has approximately 5,000 sets of dentures on display. Visitors will be able to learn a great deal about the latest technologies used in dental treatment.

Also on exhibit are overseas works from the personal collection of Mr. Wada, including many craft objects, and pictures drawn by children from around the world. One can enjoy viewing a wide range of genres of art under one roof. The chance to encounter numerous enjoyable works of art and also learn about the importance of teeth in an easy-to-understand way makes it ideal from an educational point of view for families with small children.

Plus, the stunning views of the Seto Inland Sea from different parts of the museum must be mentioned. Enjoy a well-designed combination of exhibitions of teeth and art at our dental art Heart Museum.

#### **Encounter Traditional Japanese Art**


On display is an exquisite folding screen painted by the contemporary Nihonga painter Shunso Hishida, along with sculptures and lacquerware created by famous Japanese artists, and many other works of art and craft objects. Shunso Hishida was born in 1874 in Nagano Prefecture. Active from 1907 onwards in what is currently known as the Japan Fine Arts Exhibition, he was a highly acclaimed Meiji period painter who developed a new style and is known especially for his works Ochiba (Fallen Leaves) and Kuroki Neko (Black Cat).

#### Smiles on the Faces of Children Around the World


